Pastor's Corner

“WATCH AND PRAY SO THAT YOU WILL NOT FALL INTO TEMPTATION” — MATTHEW 26:41

Beloved Parishioners,

As we begin the great season of Lent let us draw attention to temptation which is part of our daily battle in spiritual journey. The reason we harp on the possibility and occurrence of temptation at the beginning of the Lenten season is simply because whenever we are inclined to a practice of higher virtues and observances such as are demanded of us during Lent — prayer, fasting or abstinence, and alms giving, temptation to either abandon them or derail from their authentic practice abound. Jesus, upon inviting three of His disciples to prayer in the garden of Gethsemane and returning to find them heavily sleeping remarked thus: “Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation” (Matthew 26:41). This shall be an injunction and a reminder unto us as we journey through the Lenten period.

Temptation is a universal experience that every Christian faces in their walk of faith. Whether it is the lure of materialism, pride, anger, lust, or other forms of sin, temptation has been a constant challenge since the fall of man, but for us Christians, the experience of temptation is not merely a trial to endure but an opportunity to grow in faith and become more like Christ. Jesus himself was tempted three times by the devil but Jesus defeated him using the powerful words of the Scripture (Matthew 4:1-11, Mark 1:12-13, and Luke 4:1-13), and the Bible records that “When the devil had finished all this tempting, he left him until an opportune time” (Luke 4:13). This implies that the temptation by the Devil of Christians has not come to a definitive end. Thus, for every Christian, encountering temptation is inevitable since the Devil is always at work tempting every believer and testing their faith. It is for us to resolve, with the help of God and prayer, to wither the tempter's whims and caprices and grow stronger in faith.

To be sure, temptation is not a sin on its own, but what truly matters is how one responds to it. Our response to temptation determines our moral culpability. The Bible provides clear guidance on how to approach and resist temptation. In 1 Corinthians 10:13, Paul reminds Christians that, “No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.” This verse highlights two crucial elements: first, that temptation is a shared experience, and second, that God will provide a way out.

One major temptation by the devil of modern-day Christians subsists in our proclivity or inclination to think that the devil does not exist. The more we deny his existence, the more we downplay his work and get caught up in his webs. Robert Cardinal Sarah opines that “Satan loves nothing so much as the darkness in which he lies; the more hidden the devil, the more effective he is.” (Sarah, 2015). During his pontificate, Pope Francis had frequently spoken about the existence of the devil. There is no better way to understand the existence of the devil than through his works. St. Peter who once came under the scourge of the tempter's minion and who was supported by Christ's prayer (Luke 22:31-32), counsels us when he writes: “Be calm but vigilant. Because your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings.” (1 Peter 5:8-9). To be concluded next week...

Theme: Be Grounded in the Word of God

1st Sunday of Lent of the Year A, February 22, 2026

First Reading: Genesis 2:7-9, Second Reading: Romans 5:12-19, Gospel: Matthew 4:1-11

The readings of today present us with a picture of the temptations of Adam and Eve and the temptations of Jesus. The first reading narrates the fall of our first parents, Adam, and Eve and how their fall brought sin and death to the world. St. Paul says in the second reading, that sin and death entered into the world through the sin and fall of one man. We need to know what makes sin possible and how to overcome the temptation of falling into sin. Sin consists of a free act by which one cuts herself/himself from God. Adam and Eve were free to make their choices and they did it against the will of God.

Jesus teaches us how to overcome temptation that leads us to sin in his own temptation. Jesus' first strategy is firmness in standing on good resolution or decision. Confronted with any temptation there should be no room for indecision. In every temptation we are called to make a personal decision either for God or against him.

There should be absolutely no room for any dialogue. The fall of Adam and Eve started when they began to dialogue with the devil, listening to him and even encouraging him to speak. The devil takes hold of us by our weak sides. But he always packages his attacks well, he is a master of appearance. He pretends that he has something good to offer

us, for only in this way can he succeed in luring us. Jesus on the other hand conceded the devil neither minimal space nor confidence to speak. He does not let anything dissuade him from God.

The second strategy which Jesus wishes that we imbibe is to refer to the word of God, and to use it to throw light to our situation. Adam and Eve started losing the battle when they began doubting what God had told them. Adam and Eve fell because they failed to listen to the word of God. We have to be grounded in the word of God if we are to overcome the devil. The devil keeps on making suggestions to us that would make us disobey God. The Church encourages us to show great familiarity with the word of God.

The next strategy to win the devil and his temptation is prayer and mortification. That is going into our own desert because it is there that we encounter God and become truthful to our identity as children of God. Our desert can be any private moment in a private place, stripped of all distraction of the world.

Wishing you all a blessed Lenten season.

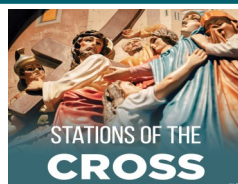

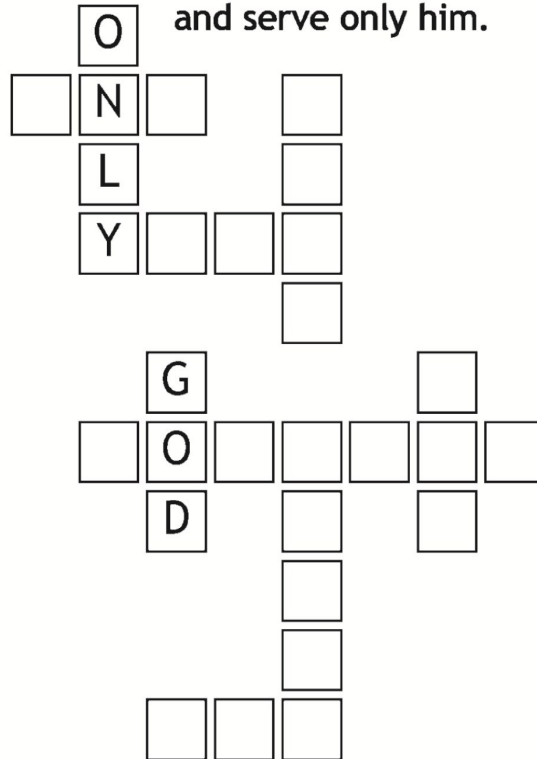

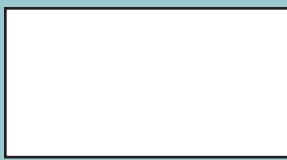
